PANDEMIC STRENGTHENS CHURCH PARTNERSHIPS

Since its founding, *CEF* has existed to serve the local church. In fact, we include the church in our mission statement—that *CEF* exists to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, disciple them in the Word of God, and establish them in the local church for Christian living. Training Centers Around the Globe



Training is an essential part of the CEF strategy to evangelize and disciple the boys and girls of the world. Last year over 270,000 people sat in a CEF training course somewhere around the world. Approximately two-thirds of those trained use what they learned in their local churches or are staff and volunteers for other mission organizations. Training centers are located all over the world, but this article will focus on only three in various stages of development.

NAIROBI

A strategic center for East and Central Africa

The East and Central Africa training center was completed in 1986 and the first classes were held that year. Since then it has been the home of multiple 12-week training courses which have equipped thousands of workers to multiply themselves in countries throughout the region. Trainings have been held in both English and French.

Staff from the Nairobi training center have been instrumental in developing additional ministry around the globe in places like Ethiopia, Sudan, Nigeria, and the Middle East. Second Timothy 2:2 instructs, "And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also." CEF believes in training and God uses it to make an eternal difference.



ETHIOPIA

First class to begin in September

The Ethiopia training center is outside its capital city Addis Ababa. This strategic center will be a tremendous resource for training workers from East and Central Africa as well as the surrounding nations. Please join us in prayer that students in the first 12-week course will be agents for growing ministry throughout the region.



INDIA

Pioneering new territory

Work has begun on the 20,000 square-foot facility. The center will prove strategic in training workers to help reach the 540 million children in India. The goal is to have three Institutes per year and utilize the center the remaining weeks for shorter training modules. We praise the Lord that resources for this center are in place.
